Overview

This document is a presentation by Vilma Tyler, Senior Nutrition Adviser, UNICEF, and was given at the 2023 Supply Forum. It summarizes key points in UNICEF's Nutrition strategy to address malnutrition, focusing on maternal and child nutrition as key priorities. The presentation details the strategy framework. It emphasizes the importance of integrated approaches, involving health, food security, water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH), and social protection systems to effectively tackle malnutrition. The strategy aims to reach the most vulnerable populations, including those affected by emergencies, with tailored interventions tailored to different contexts. It highlights the need for partnerships and collaboration with governments, civil society organizations and the private sector to achieve sustainable impact in improving nutrition outcomes for children and mothers worldwide.
