existing cleaning validation studies.

Some of the main principles of good manufacturing practices (GMP) include the

prevention of mix-ups and the prevention of contamination and cross-contamination.

Multi-product facilities in particular, have a potential risk of cross-contamination. It is

therefore important that manufacturers identify all risks relating to contamination and

cross-contamination and identify and implement the appropriate controls to mitigate

these risk.
