

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR MICRONUTRIENT PRODUCTS

Overview

The document outlines general specifications and requirements applicable to all micronutrient products in all formats except parenterals, procured by UNICEF. Product-specific specifications are detailed in solicitation activities, Long-Term Arrangement Contracts, and Purchase Orders. **Suppliers must adhere to both the technical requirements and unique product specifications, as they complement each other.**

It covers requirements for micronutrient products procured by UNICEF, including sections on:

- Quality, safety, and efficacy requirements for micronutrient products
- Regulatory compliance and alignment with international standards (GMP, pharmacopeias)
- Manufacturing, stability, packaging, and labelling requirements
- Supplier qualification, quality systems, and lifecycle management
- Annex: Supplier qualification process overview (narrative + flowchart)
- Annex: Defined product scope
- Appendix: Risk-based change management with practical examples

Suppliers are requested to read the three documents in conjunction with one another: IAFPPQ, TQPM and Technical Requirements for Micronutrient Products.
