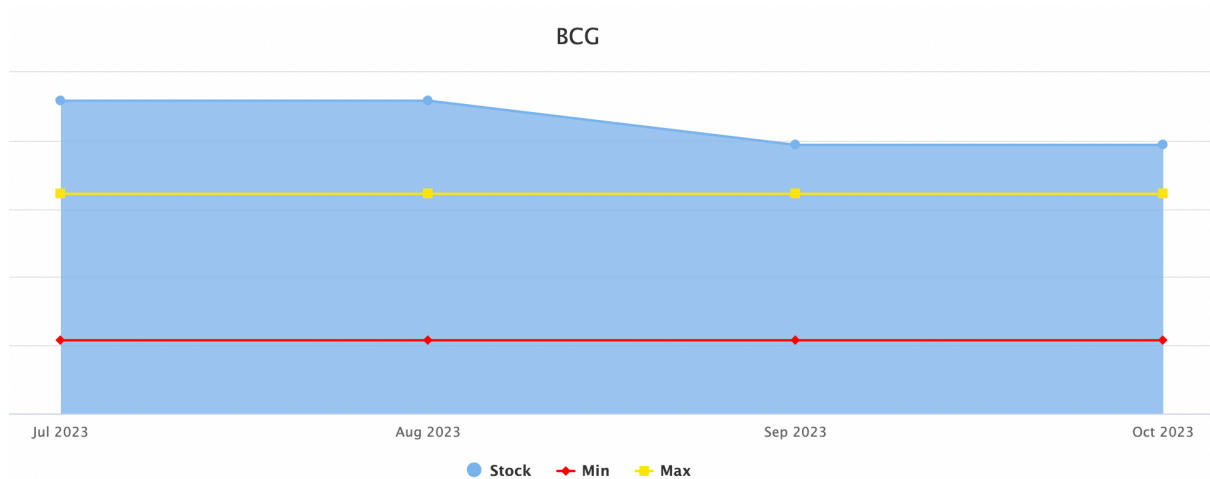
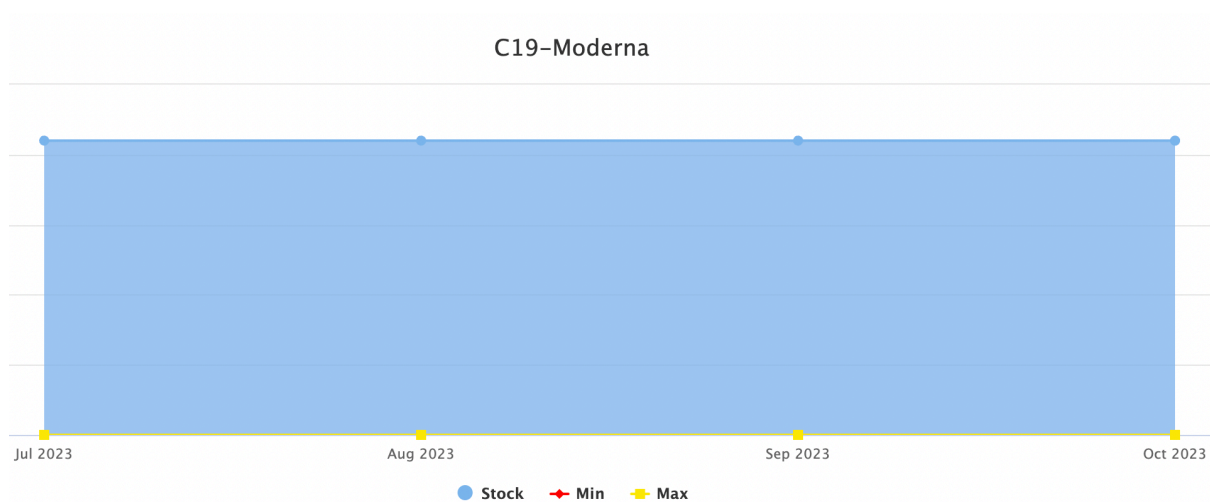


Stocked According To Plan charts: The min / max lines are missing

On the Stocked According to Plan report, the user can monitor the stock during a selected period by comparing it to the minimum and maximum recommended levels on the chart.



However, in some cases, the minimum and maximum levels might not show, or might show at zero, like in the example below.



If you experience this, verify the following:

- The activity type showing is “Default” (routine + supplementary) or “Routine” has been selected. If the activity selected is “SIA”, the minimum and maximum lines will not show, as these parameters are not calculated for supplementary supplies.
- The item has been registered on the list of routine immunization products under the program Data for the current year. If you have administrator rights, review the list of the “Program Data” tab, otherwise, request support from your SMT administrator.

- The population data for your store and target groups percentage is completed. If you have administrator rights, review the tables under the “Store Data” > “Population & Demographics” tab, otherwise, request support from your SMT administrator.
- The expected vaccine coverage for all items and supply chain levels is completed. If you have administrator rights, review the tables under the “Store Data” > “Vaccine coverage” tab, otherwise, request support from your SMT administrator.
- The Safety Stock, Supply Interval and Lead Time values for all supply chain levels are completed. If you have administrator rights, review the tables under the “Store Data” > “Stock Levels & Lead Time” tab, otherwise, request support from your SMT administrator.
